



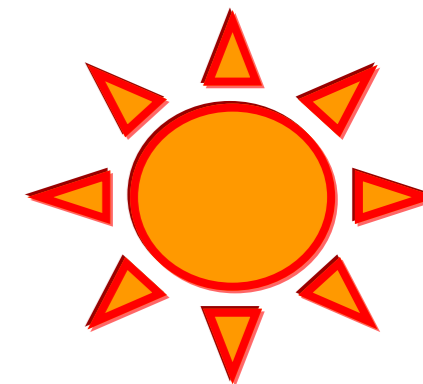

For parents who need an **extended camp day** due to scheduling, your child may be dropped-off early and picked-up late. Campers will be supervised by staff at the BCC Field House.

Camp Sumner has a Native American theme. The units are:

Cherokee (Entering Kindergarten and 1st grade)

The youngest unit is joyful and begins the camp experience for children. Each day of camp is filled with the excitement that comes from trying new things! Daily schedules provide a balance between active and quiet play and group and individual activities.



Laguna (Entering 2nd grade)

Our more experienced campers will enjoy new challenges and new excitement. Emphasis in this unit is on increased self-confidence, encouraging others, responsibility and cooperation within the group team.

Tuscarora (Entering 3rd and 4th grade)

As the child grows so will their camp experience. Emphasis in this unit is on increased self-confidence, encouraging others, responsibility and cooperation within the group team. Tuscarora may also choose their activity of interesting the morning as well as in the afternoon, as they are now a littler older and more experienced than the Laguna unit.

Abenaki (Entering 5th and 6th grade)

Our most experienced campers at camp will take leadership programs and specialized activities that are designed to be progressive and challenging as well as fun and entertaining to the Abenaki unit. As the oldest unit, Abenaki may choose their activities of interest in both morning and afternoon.

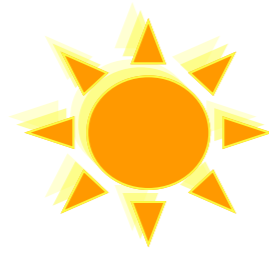
Leaders in Training (LIT)

NEW Junior Golf Camp

Two Junior Golf Camps, will be offered at BCC and conducted by Kay McMahon, Director of eduKaytion golf, along with her staff this year.

During the half-day morning camp, juniors will be divided by age and experience levels to learn how to play, swing techniques, short game shots, putting, and etiquette by using games, skills and drills. Camp Summer Staff

Camp Summer prides itself on providing a fine staff of qualified personnel. Many of our staff members are teachers and college students who have been participants themselves and all have a minimum of 1 year experience working with children. The staff participates in an extensive training session. All of our lifeguards are certified and trained in their respective area. The YMCA is committed to recruiting and developing an outstanding group of counselors and directors that are dedicated to providing the best possible summer program experience.

Important Information

NOTE: Camp Summer will be held at Berkshire Community College's Paterson Field House.

1. Please read the registration information and camper application carefully. Applications must be fully completed and signed where indicated.
2. Makes checks payable to the Pittsfield Family YMCA in the amount of the required deposit stated on the form. This \$35 deposit is applied to camp tuition, but is not refundable.
3. Mail or deliver the registration form with deposit to: Pittsfield Family YMCA; 292 North Street; Pittsfield, MA 01201.
4. If a participant cancels an enrollment prior to the start, the YMCA will issue a credit or refund minus the \$35 non-refundable deposit. After the program has met twice, no credits or refunds will be issued
5. There will be a charge of \$10 for any private-pay payment research requests.
6. Children attending camp must have a medical physical by a licensed physician within 12 months preceding the start of camp.
7. Final payment is due two weeks prior to your child's first day of camp or the space will be forfeited. Please be sure to put your child's name on the check. Final payments may be made by mail or in person at our main office on North Street .
8. There will be a \$25 fee for returned checks.
9. There will be a fee of \$1 per minute for children who are picked up late.

Health and Safety

The health and safety of your child at the YMCA programs is our first priority. All staff are certified in First Aid and CPR, and the health care administrator is on-site daily. Camp Summer is licensed by the State of Massachusetts Board of Health.

Camp Financial Assistance Information

The YMCA has a limited amount of financial assistance available for families who fall within our sliding scale. **You must meet our eligibility guidelines and the YMCA reserves the right to deny or discontinue service at any time.**

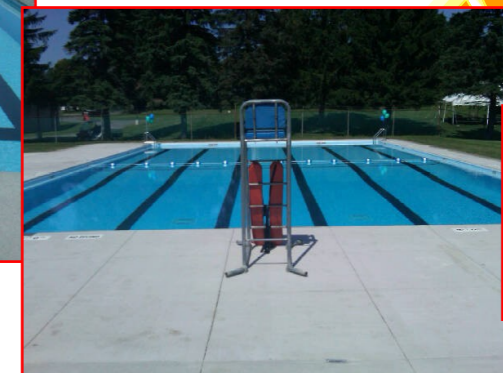
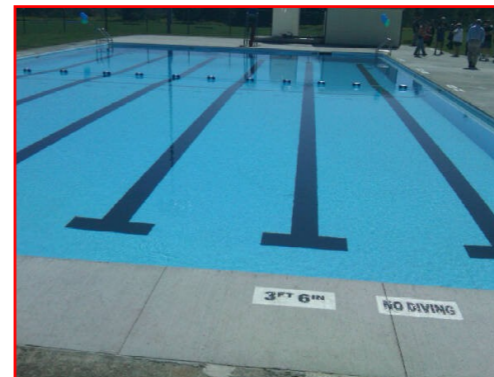
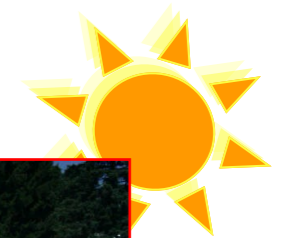


Eligibility

- Families must work or reside in the YMCA service area
- Assistance will be granted on financial need for low income on a first-come first-serve basis
- Financial assistance is for the current camp year only
- Prior account balances must be paid in full before applying

Application

- Application must be filled out completely
- One month of current pay stubs must be submitted with the application or other form of income (SSI, etc) Copies of documentation must be provided.
- A "Thank you" letter needs to be submitted with application
- A registration deposit of \$25.00 is required in order to process an application which will be credited to your camp deposit, but is non-refundable if you decide not to attend the camp.
- Household size as well as the age and date of birth of all children within the household must be specified within the application.
- Applicants will be notified by mail of their award in order to confirm the supplied mailing address.
